

The Africa Regional Sexuality Resource Center's library is the only clearinghouse of sexuality resources in Africa. Its collection of over 1000 gray literature, sexuality research findings and gold standard publications are diverse, with particular emphasis on Africa. Some subject areas include,

1. Sexuality and Religion 2. Sexuality and HIV and AIDS 3. Adolescent Sexuality 4. Men and Women's Health 5. Sexual Health 6. Gender and Rights 7. Masculinities 8. Sexuality and Disability 9. Sexual Minorities issues 10. Sexuality and the Law, 11, Rape, Sexual Harrassement and Abuse, Social Work and also Journals such as Reproducutive Health Matters, Culture, Health and Sexuality, Sex Education and Learning, Sex Research, African Journal of Reproductive Health, Violence Against Women, Journal of Adolescence, Studies in Gender and Sexuality but to mention a few.

Online databases like the World Health Organization (WHO), Health Internet work Access to Research Initiative (HINARI) to mention just a few, are accessible through the library and links to other electronic resources are also available.

Library users also have access to one of the world's largest collections of biomedical literature, offered by leading biomedical publishers such as Taylor and Francis, Elsevier, Lancet, BMJ, to mention but a few. Work stations/ports for internet access to aid and facilitate research work for researchers, photocopier and a Scanner are also available in a main reading area that can accommodate up to 12 users at a time. The library is open to Sexuality and Allied professionals, Independent Researchers, NGOs, Activists, Program Staff and Project Managers, University Lecturers, Research Centers, Donors and Policy Makers on the African continent.

Membership and use of library is also open to undergraduate and postgraduate students with demonstrable research needs related to the field of human sexuality. Registration requirements include

2. 2 passport photographs
3. Registration forms returned with completed referee forms.
