Instructions for article writing:

The article should be written in Microsoft Word.

Length of the article: max. 18.000 marks (no more than 10 standard pages)

Instruction concerning to textbook page format of academic article: page margins: top 1,7, bottom 1,8, back 2,3, fore-edge 1,5, format A5.

Line spacing: single spacing. Recommended font: Times New Roman. Font size: 10b.

Structure of academic articles:

- Heading** write from the left margin with bold, font size 12, do not separate the words.
- Heading in English** write from the left margin with bold, font size 12, do not separate the words.
- Authors** Name, surname - write from the left margin without academic titles (do not abbreviate), specify the place of work and the state in abbreviation form.
- Abstract in English** use 4 - 6 lines to characterize professional aspects of your academic article (methods, resources, results). Write without sections from the left margin.
- Key words in English** One and more words in two or three lines specifying the main themes of article. Start to write from the left margin.
- Text** Headings write in bold from the left margin.
Do not separate words at the end of the lines.
Use the link concerning to literature used in text in the following form in brackets: (surname, year of issue and page).
Number tables, pictures, schemes and place them into the text.
- References** Ordered in alphabetical order. Specify main bibliographic data (AUTHOR – large size, title, place where publication was edited, editor, imprint year, number of pages, ISBN).
- Author's address** title, name, surname, street and number, post code, place of work, state, e-mail, telephone number.
