General Information

The Library is located in the Action Health Incorporated building. The main reading area is up-stairs and accommodates 12 readers at a time. Provision has been made for carrels, which can accommodate 6 readers at any given time. It also houses the Special and the Reserve Collections. The whole Library is fully air-conditioned and enjoys access to the World Wide Web.

Admissions to the Library.

The ARSRC Library collection is available to sexuality and allied professionals, relevant NGOs, activists, project managers, university and research centers, donors and policy makers on the African continent. Membership and use of the library is open to undergraduates students with demonstrable research needs related to the field of human sexuality.

The Library may admit for reference only i.e. without privilege of borrowing, the following:

- (a) Researchers from higher Institutions of learning
- (b) Staff dependants
- (c) Persons granted permission in special circumstances, or requiring quick reference services.

Registration requirements:

- (a) Interested applicants must present valid identification cards or documents
- (b) Registration forms must be completed and returned with appropriate documentary requirements such as completed referee forms

N.B. (a) All library users must be registered and can only be admitted after being issued a library registration ticket. This ticket must always be shown to any official or staff of the Library on demand. Entry may be prohibited to anyone who fails to produce it.

(b) Library cards will be made available within one week from the date registration procedures are completed

(c) Registration is valid for only one year after which it must be renewed.

Staff

The Library has well trained staff who are prepared to make library resources available to you. All problems arising from difficulties in locating materials and enquiries concerning bibliographic/reference materials enquiries should be directed to the Library staff. Please do not hesitate to ask the staff on duty for any information whatsoever.

Instruction in the use of the Library

Library staff members are always prepared to advise and assist individuals or small groups of readers in the Library and to offer instructions on the techniques of searching for published literature, on any subject.

For each book, there is an entry in the database and searches can be made under the names of the authors, titles, subject, etc as the case might be.

How to find a book/material in the Library

- (a) If a user has prior knowledge of the name of the Author, Editor, Subject, Title, Keyword, or Series of a book, he/she should look it up in the database using one of computer access points. The reader should locate the class-mark found on the entry and proceed to the shelves using that class mark to find the book. The Library has a shelf-guide to help you know the right shelf.

Borrowing of Books/Materials **(This Service is currently Not Available but Will Be Made Available in the Future)**

Serials:

The Library has on order some serial titles. Current issues of a few selected titles are displayed on arrival in the Serials Section of the Library and may be consulted on the tables beside the display racks. Journals are available in the fields of Sexuality, Sexual Health, Sexual Rights, and Gender etc.

Journals are arranged alphabetically by title on the Shelves in the Serials Section. A Library staff is always available in the Section to assist any reader who encounters difficulties in locating the materials. All bound issues are arranged according to their subjects on the shelves.

Newspapers

The current issues of Nigerian newspapers are also available. A reader may request this from staff members.

Rules and Regulations (Library Regulations)

General

1. All readers must fill in a Library registration card, before making use of Library facilities.
2. Registration is valid for one year only and must be renewed thereafter.
3. Brief cases, bags, umbrellas and raincoats must not be brought within the Library. All such items should be kept with the Porters.
4. Drinking of tea or coffee is forbidden in the Library.
5. Smoking is also forbidden in the Library.
6. Loud conversation is strictly forbidden in the Library
7. Library equipment or furniture must not be tampered with or operated without the permission of the Librarian. Anything requiring attention should be brought to the notice of the Library staff on duty.
8. Books damaged should be reported to the Library immediately and paid for at the current estimated cost of replacement.
9. All cases of stealing and defacing of books will be regarded as serious offences and the offender(s) dealt with very severely.
10. The Librarian reserves the right to suspend all Library privilege from persons who contravene these regulations and to report such cases to the appropriate authority for further action

11. For security reasons, readers are requested to enter and leave the Library only through the main door.
12. Books, periodicals, and other Library materials consulted must be left on the reading tables or returned to the Circulation Desk, as appropriate. Readers should not attempt to reshell them.
13. Silence should be maintained at all times.
